

PURPOSE & PHILOSOPHY

The Lincoln Before and After School Program is a non-profit corporation, organized to provide before and after school care for children in Kindergarten through Sixth grade.

The program will offer a variety of activities to help stimulate self expression, exploration and further development of the children in a safe, friendly environment.

Please note for the 2018-2019 school year we will only offer after school care due to being located at the New Hoover Elementary School and many children will be utilizing district bus service creating no need for a before school care program. We plan to return to offering a before school care program once we return to the newly renovated Lincoln Elementary School.

ORGANIZATION

The program is licensed by the Iowa Department of Human Services. The program is incorporated in the State of Iowa as a non-profit corporation.

Admissions School Year

Any child enrolled in Kindergarten through Sixth grade at Lincoln Elementary School is eligible for admission. Applications are accepted year-round, provided that the application is completed in full, and a registration fee (\$50) has been paid.

The program encourages students of all backgrounds to attend. The program does not discriminate against anyone because of race, sex, color, creed, national origin or ethnic background.

Hours of Program

After School will start by the end of the school day until **6pm**.

Program Cost

The cost for program is \$200 per month but is subject to change by the start of the school year.

Schedule of Activities

School Dismissal

Lincoln students will go to the main gym to find a basket to put their belongings in. They will check in with a staff taking attendance and getting ready to go outside for an extra recess (weather pending)

Free Play

After every student is checked in our whole program will go outside and play on our wonderful playground until snack is ready and Mann BASP is done with their snack time.

Snack Time

Each Day students will get a snack to hold them over until they are picked up. Students are not allowed to bring their own snacks unless parents have talked with the director. Most snacks consist of 1 carb, 1 protein, and something with fiber such as apples, salads, ect.

Reading/Writing/Homework Time

After students are done eating, they will have time to work on school work or read or write for leisure. If parents have specific things for students to work on during this time, please contact program director.

Group Game

Large group game either outside or inside along with a large group meeting to discuss students interest and concerns

Art/Clubs

At least 2 times a week students will be allowed to have a art project or a club or their choice. Clubs change throughout the year.

Closing/Cleaning/Small Group Time

Small groups similar to clubs give students additional time to work on something with others or collectively.
